

# Heritage Blanket Crochet Pattern (UK Terms)

## Snapdragon Stitch

You will need:



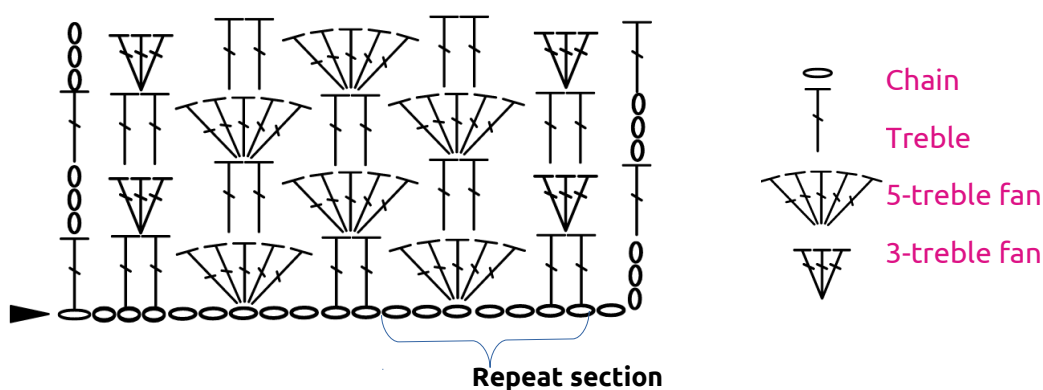
You will need:

- Standard Crochet hook 5mm
- 25g DK wool colour of your choice

Useful abbreviations to read the pattern

- **St** – stitch **Sts** – stitches **Ch** – chain
- **tr** – treble stitch **5-tr** – 5 treble fan **3-tr** – 3 treble fan

Sample Diagram:



Pattern (multiple of 7 + 5ch):

NOTE: If you are joining to the other squares, then make sure that the foundation row is 8 inches. If your row 0 is smaller than 8 inches in length, then add multiples of 7 chain + 5ch until it makes approximately 8 inches in width.

- ❑ **Row 0:** Chain 19 + 3ch for turning
- ❑ **Row 1:** Tr into 5<sup>th</sup> ch from hook, 1tr into next st, \* skip 2 sts, 5-tr into next st, skip 2 sts, 1 tr in next 2 sts, - repeat from \* across **until 4 sts left** then 1 tr in next 2 sts, skip next st, 1 tr into last st
- ❑ **Row 2:** ch3, 3-tr into middle of 2tr from previous row, \* 1tr into 2<sup>nd</sup> gap of fan from previous row, 1 tr into 3<sup>rd</sup> gap of fan from previous row, 5-tr into middle of 2tr from previous row – repeat from \* across **until last 2tr from previous row reached**, then 3-tr into middle of 2tr from previous row, 1 tr into top of ch3 from previous row.
- ❑ **Row 3:** ch3, 1 tr into 1<sup>st</sup> gap of 3-tr from previous row, 1 tr into 2<sup>nd</sup> gap of 3tr from previous row, \* 1tr into 2<sup>nd</sup> gap of fan from previous row, 1 tr into 3<sup>rd</sup> gap of fan from previous row, 5-tr into middle of 2tr from previous row – repeat from \* across **until last 3-tr fan from previous row reached**, then 1 tr into 1<sup>st</sup> gap of 3-tr from previous row, 1 tr into 2<sup>nd</sup> gap of 3tr from previous row, 1 tr into top of ch3 from previous row.
- ❑ Repeat row 2 and 3 until desired height reached.

Finishing

- ❑ Add a border of 1 double crochet (dc) evenly spaced around the edges with 3 dc in the corner stitches. Tie off and weave in ends
