Basket Weave Stitch

Crochet Pattern (UK Terms)

You will need:


You will need:

- Crochet Hook 5/6mm
- 25g DK wool colour of your choice

Useful abbreviations to read pattern


- **St** – stitch Sts – stitches **Slst** – Slipstitch **StM** – Stitch Marker
- **Ch** – chain
- **dc** – double crochet
- **htr** – half treble crochet
- **YO** – yarn over

Back Post Treble (Bptr)

YO, insert hook around the post of the stitch from the previous row, YO and pull up a loop to the height of the last st (or ch3) and then complete the treble st as normal – stitch will sit to the back of the work and leave a ridge on the front



Front Post Treble (Fptr)

YO, insert hook from front to back around the post of the stitch from the previous row, YO and pull up a loop to the height of the last st (or ch3) and then complete the treble st as normal – stitch will sit to the front of the work and leave a ridge on the back

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Pattern (multiple of 6 + 4 ch)

If you are joining to the other squares, then make sure that the foundation row is 8 inches (in multiple of 2). If your initial row is smaller than 8 inches, then add multiples of 2 chains until it makes 8 inches in width.

- [ROW 0].** [FOUNDATION ROW] Chain 28 (or a multiple of 6 + 4 which reaches 8 inches in width)
- [ROW 1].** Tr into 4th st from hook, * 1 tr in each of remaining st across (26 stitches)
- [ROW 2].** Ch2, turn, * work Fptr round first three tr (ignoring edge tr), work Bptr around next three tr – repeat from * across, tr into last st (26 stitches)
- [ROW 3].** Ch2, turn, * work Fptr round first three tr (ignoring edge tr), work Bptr around next three tr – repeat from * across, tr into last st (26 stitches)
- [ROW 4].** Ch2, turn, * work Bptr round first three tr (ignoring edge tr), work Fptr around next three tr – repeat from * across, tr into last st (26 stitches)
- [ROW 5].** Ch2, turn, * work Bptr round first three tr (ignoring edge tr), work Fptr around next three tr – repeat from * across, tr into last st (26 stitches)
- [ROW 6].** Repeat rows 2-5 until work measures 8 inches in height
- [ROW 7].** DO NOT TIE OFF – work 1 dc evenly spaced around the entire edge of the piece making sure you put 3dc into the corner stitch. Slipstitch to join – tie off and weave in ends.
