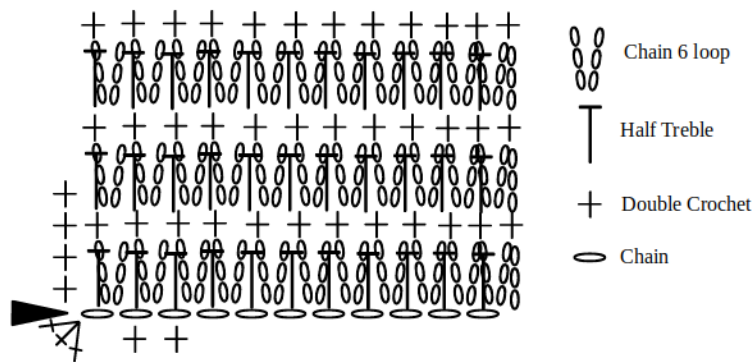
Loopy Loops Stitch

Crochet Pattern (UK Terms)

You will need:

You will need:	Useful abbreviations to read the pattern
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Crochet Hook 5mm ▪ 25g DK wool colour of your choice 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ St – stitch ▪ Sts – stitches ▪ Ch – chain ▪ tr – treble crochet ▪ dc – double crochet

Diagram



Pattern (multiple of 1 + 3ch for turning)

NOTE: If you are joining to the other squares, then make sure that the foundation row is 8 inches. If your row 0 is smaller than 8 inches in length, then add multiples of 1 chain until it makes 8 inches in width, then add 3 ch to turn. The loops should all be on ONE side of the work.

- ❑ **Row 0:** Chain 25 + 3ch (for turning) – see note above for width
- ❑ **Row 1:** 1htr into 3rd ch from hook, 1tr in each st along
- ❑ **Row 2:** Ch1, turn work, * 1dc into next st then chain a loop of 6ch - repeat from * along row until last st, 1 dc into last st.
- ❑ **Row 3:** Ch3, turn work, 1 htr into each st in the middle of each ch6 loop along with last htr into top of ch1 from previous row.
- ❑ **Row 4:** Repeat Row 2
- ❑ **Row 5:** Repeat Row 3
- ❑ **Row 6 +:** Repeat alternating rows 4 and 5 until the height of 8 inches reached. Tie off and weave in ends unless doing a border (see below).

Finishing

- ❑ Add a border of 1 double crochet (dc) evenly spaced around the edges with 3 dc in the corner stitches. Tie off and weave in ends
 - See diagram – bottom left hand corner for placement of dc border to get an even finish
