

# Heritage Blanket

## Open Ridge Stitch Square

Crochet Pattern (UK Terms)

You will need:

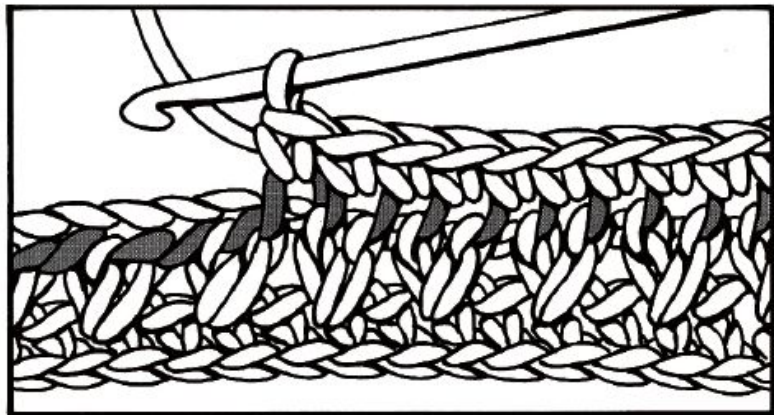
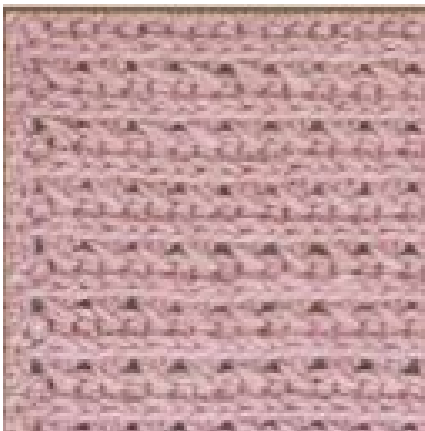
You will need:

- Crochet Hook 5mm
- 25g DK wool colour of your choice

Useful abbreviations to read pattern

- **St** – stitch Sts – stitches **Slst** – Slipstitch **StM** – Stitch Marker
- **Ch** – chain
- **dc** – double crochet
- **htr** – half treble crochet

Pattern (multiple of 2 + 1 ch)

If you are joining to the other squares, then make sure that the foundation row is 8 inches. If your initial row is smaller than 8 inches, then add multiples of 2 chains until it makes 8 inches in width.

- [ROW 0].** [FOUNDATION ROW] Chain 25 (or a multiple of 2 + 1 which reaches 8 inches in width)
- [ROW 1].** Dc into 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook, 1 dc into each remaining ch across
- [ROW 2].** Ch2, turn work, half treble (htr), \* skip next st, htr in next st, htr in skipped st – repeat from \* for remainder of row until last st, htr in last st
- [ROW 3].** Ch1, turn work, \* dc into the lower horizontal strand (see diagram) of htr from previous row – repeat from \* along piece of work
- [ROW 4].** Repeat row 3 and 4 until work measures 8 inches in height
- [ROW 5].** DO NOT TIE OFF – work 1 dc evenly spaced around the entire edge of the piece making sure you put 3dc into the corner stitch. Slipstitch to join – tie off and weave in ends.
