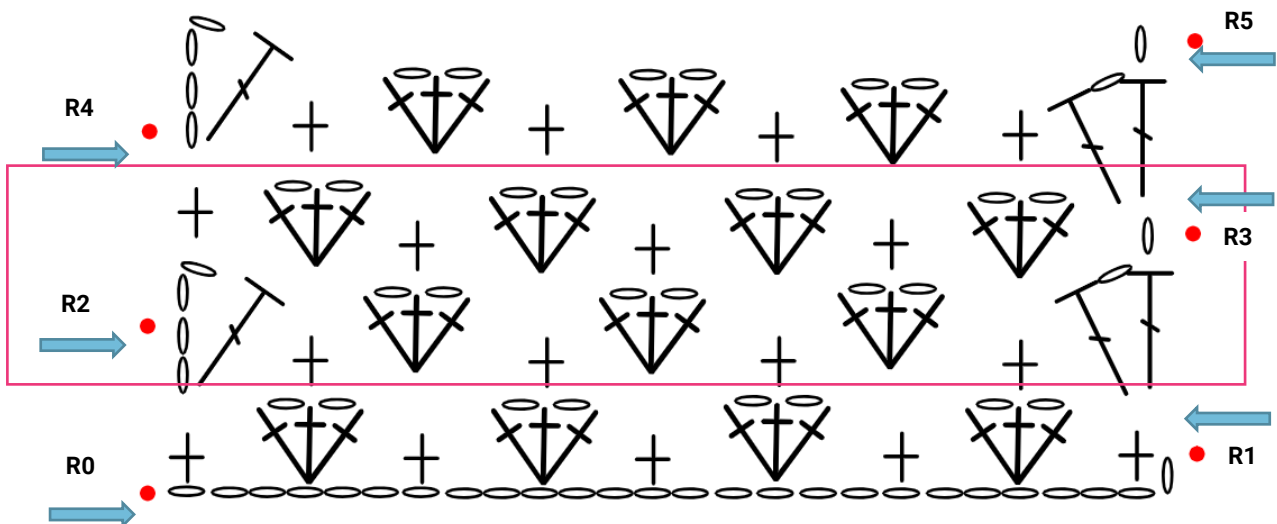
## Trinity Stitch Square

Crochet Pattern (UK Terms)

You will need:

You will need:	Useful abbreviations to read pattern
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Crochet Hook 5mm</li> <li>▪ 25g DK wool colour of your choice</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>St</b> – stitch Sts – stitches <b>Slst</b> – Slipstitch <b>StM</b> – Stitch Marker</li> <li>▪ <b>Ch</b> – chain</li> <li>▪ <b>dc</b> – double crochet</li> <li>▪ <b>Fan stitch</b> – [tr, ch1, tr, ch1, tr] into same st</li> <li>▪ <b>Half Fan</b> – [tr, ch, tr] into same st</li> </ul>

Pattern (multiple of 4 + 1 ch)

If you are joining to the other squares, then make sure that the foundation row is 8 inches. If your initial row is smaller than 8 inches, then add multiples of 6 chains + 4ch until it makes 8 inches in width.

- [ROW 0]. Row 0:** Pattern is in multiples of 6 + 2ch. For this square we have 4 sections so ch 24 (4 sections of 6ch) + 2ch
- [ROW 1]. Row1:** dc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook (place Stitch Marker (SM) into this st), \* skip 2 ch, Fan stitch [tr, ch1, tr, ch1, tr into same st], skip 2 ch, dc into 3<sup>rd</sup> ch - Repeat from \* 5 more times. Place SM into last dc of row.
- [ROW 2]. Row 2:** Ch4 (counts as tr + 1 ch), tr into first ch from ch4, \* dc into middle of fan from previous row, Fan stitch [tr, ch1, tr, ch1, tr into same st] into dc from previous row <sup>1</sup> - Repeat from \* until you reach SM (remove). Half fan into last st [tr, ch1, tr].
- [ROW 3]. Row 3:** Ch 1 (counts as dc so put your SM in here), \* Fan Stitch into dc from previous row, dc into middle of fan stitch from previous row – repeat from \* until you reach SM (remove)
- [ROW 4]. Row 4 – x:** Repeat rows 2 and 3 until the square reaches the desired height (8inches).
- [ROW 5]. Border:** 3 dc into corner, 1 dc in the stitches on the edge (evenly spaced along edges)

<sup>1</sup> If you are having trouble finding dc then fan stitch into the middle of the V dip.
