STANDARD UK BOOK SIZES :
 FICTION 4.5 X 7 INCHES HARDBACK 5.5 X 8.5 INCHES (Repeat twice for front and back)
 NON STANDARD: Measure front cover x2 to make sure your foundation row is the right length + 4ch for border and joining/detatch stitch

A	Backpost double crochet (uk) IN YARN COLOUR A	B	Border column
B	Backpost double crochet (uk) IN YARN COLOUR B	JD	joining/detatch stitch
X	FRTR - Front Ridge Treble Crochet (made into the ridge of the last st made in same colour)		
C	Backpost double crochet (uk) IN YARN COLOUR C IF YOU WANT A COLOUR CHANGE		

INSTRUCTIONS
 Mosaic crochet is worked in one direction only. Therefore at the end of each row tie off and leave tail of 4 cm. Make sure you always include column B and the border stitch as we will be attaching our final border to this stitch. If you want to change colours then change yarn to a different colour every 14 rows (see blue outline for rows 15-28 showing yarn C). Column 0 will be hidden remember the foundation row should be the width of your book + 2 ch as these will be hidden at the end. Repeat from row 1 if you want to go higher than row 36. Row 0 and 37 is the border. Add row 37 when you get to the height.
