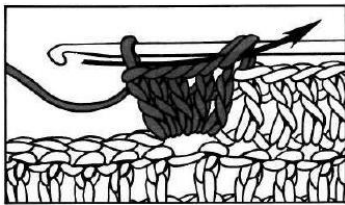
Fan and Popcorn

Crochet Pattern (UK Terms)

You will need:

You will need:	Useful abbreviations to read pattern
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Crochet Hook 5mm ▪ 25g DK wool colour of your choice 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ St – stitch Sts – stitches Slst – Slipstitch StM – Stitch Marker ▪ Ch – chain ▪ htr – half treble crochet

Work 5 tr into same st.

Remove hook from loop and insert into top of first tr and last tr (which you just removed hook from – 2 loops on hook), yarn over and pull through both loops and ch1 to lock popcorn.

Pattern (multiple of 10 + 6 ch)

If you are joining to the other squares, then make sure that the foundation row is 8 inches. If your row 0 is smaller than 8 inches in length, then add multiples of 7 chain until it makes 8 inches in width.

There is a right side (patterned side) and wrong side (working side) with this pattern so make sure you read the pattern carefully to prevent putting the pattern on the wrong side!

[ROW 1]. Chain 25 + 1ch (for turning) – see note above for width

[ROW 2]. Dc in 2nd chain from hook, 1dc into remaining st across

- a. To prevent your sides going wonky mark the 1st and last st using a StM and move StM with each row increase.

[ROW 3]. **[Right side]** ch3 (counts as first dc), turn work, 1 dc in next st, work popcorn (see above) in next st, * skip 4 sts, 9 tr in next st, skip next 4 sts, work popcorn in next – repeat from * twice more, 1tr into last st

[ROW 4]. **[Wrong side]** ch1, turn work, 1dc in each st across (approx. 25 dc)

[ROW 5]. Repeat row 3

[ROW 6]. Repeat row 4

[ROW 7]. Repeat pattern of row alternation until work reaches 8inches in height.

[ROW 8]. **Border:** 3 dc into corner st, 1 dc along edge (evenly spaced along edges) – repeat around the square till 4 sides complete. Slst to join, tie off and weave in end.
