

Heritage Blanket Crochet Pattern (UK Terms)

Woven Relief Stitch

You will need:

You will need:	Useful abbreviations to read the pattern
<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Crochet Hook 5mm▪ 25g DK wool colour of your choice	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ St – stitch Sts – stitches Ch – chain▪ dc – Double crochet tr – treble crochet▪ FPtr – Front Post Tr BPTR – Back Post Treble

Diagram:



Pattern (multiple of 6 + 3ch and 1ch for turning):

NOTE: If you are joining to the other squares, then make sure that the foundation row is 8 inches. If your row 0 is smaller than 8 inches in length, then add multiples of 6 chain + 3 until it makes 8 inches in width, then add 3 ch to turn.

- Row 0:** Chain 27 – *see note above for width*
- Row 1:** 1tr in 4th ch from hook, 1tr in each st across
- Row 2:** Ch3, turn, Fptr in next 5 sts posts, Bptr, * Fptr in next 5 sts posts, Bptr – repeat from * across with Fptr around last st post.
- Row 3:** Ch3, turn, Bptr around next 2 posts, fptr, * Bptr around next 5 st posts, Fptr – repeat from * across with Bptr around last st post
- Row 4+:** Repeat Rows 2 and 3 alternating until desired height reached.

Finishing

- Add a border of 1 double crochet (dc) evenly spaced around the edges with 3 dc in the corner stitches. Tie off and weave in ends
