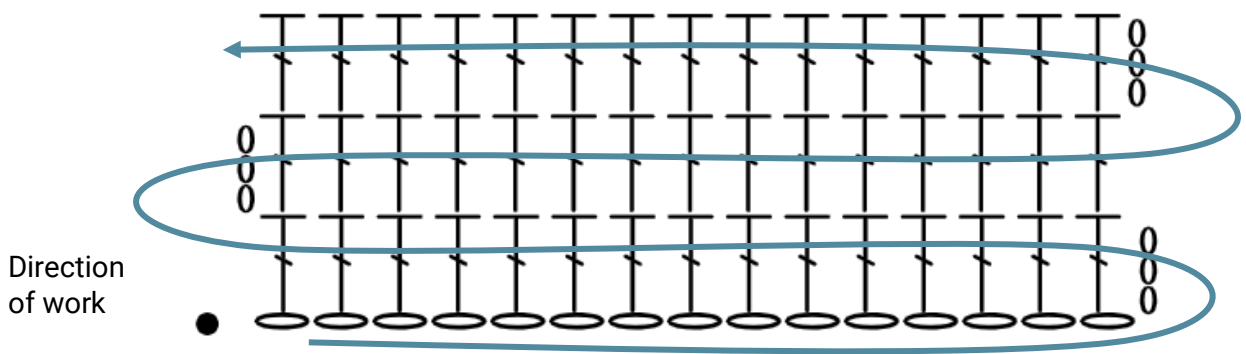
## Treble Square

Crochet Pattern (UK Terms)

You will need:

You will need:	Useful abbreviations to read pattern
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Crochet Hook 5mm</li> <li>▪ 25g DK wool colour of your choice</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>St</b> – stitch Sts – stitches <b>Slst</b> – Slipstitch <b>StM</b> – Stitch Marker</li> <li>▪ <b>Ch</b> – chain</li> <li>▪ <b>tr</b> – treble crochet</li> </ul>

Pattern (multiple of 1 + 1 turning ch)

If you are joining to the other squares, then make sure that the foundation row is 8 inches. If your row 0 is smaller than 8 inches in length, then add multiples of 1 chain until it makes 8 inches in width.

**[ROW 0].** Chain 27 + 3ch (for turning) – see note above for width

**[ROW 1].** Treble (tr) in 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook and in each ch across [27 approx.]

- To prevent your sides going wonky mark the 1<sup>st</sup> and last st using a StM and move StM with each row increase.

**[ROW 2].** Ch1, turn work, 1 tr in to each st across [27 approx.]

**[ROW 3].** Repeat row 2 until the work is approximately 8 inches in height – do not tie off

**[ROW 4].** **Border:** 3 dc into corner st, 1 dc along edge (evenly spaced along edges) – repeat around the square till 4 sides complete. Slst to join, tie off and weave in end.
