Chevron Relief

Crochet Pattern (UK Terms)

You will need:

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- Crochet Hook 5mm
- 25g DK wool colour of your choice

Useful abbreviations to read pattern

- **St** – stitch **Sts** – stitches **Slst** – Slipstitch **StM** – Stitch Marker
- **Ch** – chain
- **htr** – half treble crochet

Pattern (multiple of 7 + 4 ch)

If you are joining to the other squares, then make sure that the foundation row is 8 inches. If your row 0 is smaller than 8 inches in length, then add multiples of 7 chain until it makes 8 inches in width.

There is a right side (patterned side) and wrong side (working side) with this pattern so make sure you read the pattern carefully to prevent putting the pattern on the wrong side!

[ROW 1]. Chain 24 + 1ch (for turning) – see note above for width

[ROW 2]. Dc in 2nd chain from hook, 1dc into remaining st across

- a. To prevent your sides going wonky mark the 1st and last st using a StM and move StM with each row increase.

[ROW 3]. **[wrong side]** ch1, turn work, htr into first dc, 1htr in remaining st across

[ROW 4]. **[right side]** ch2, turn work, htr in first 2 dc, * fptr around htr post from previous row twice and skip st behind fptr, htr in next 5 sts – repeat from * across to last st of row and htr in last one

[ROW 5]. **[wrong side]** Repeat row 3

[ROW 6]. **[right side]** ch2, turn work, htr in first 3 dc, * fptr around htr post from previous row twice and skip st behind fptr, htr in next 5 sts – repeat from * across

[ROW 7]. **[wrong side]** Repeat row 3

[ROW 8]. **[right side]** ch2, turn work, htr in first 4 dc, * fptr around htr post from previous row twice and skip st behind fptr, htr in next 5 sts – repeat from * across

[ROW 9]. **[wrong side]** Repeat row 3

[ROW 10]. **[right side]** ch2, turn work, htr in first 5 dc, * fptr around htr post from previous row twice and skip st behind fptr, htr in next 5 sts – repeat from * across

[ROW 11]. **[wrong side]** Repeat row 3

[ROW 12]. **[right side]** ch2, turn work, htr in first 6 dc, * fptr around htr post from previous row twice and skip st behind fptr, htr in next 5 sts – repeat from * across

[ROW 13]. **[wrong side]** Repeat row 3

[ROW 14]. **[right side]** ch2, turn work, htr in first 5 dc, * fptr around htr post from previous row twice and skip st behind fptr, htr in next 5 sts – repeat from * across

[ROW 15]. **[wrong side]** Repeat row 3

[ROW 16]. **[right side]** ch2, turn work, htr in first 4 dc, * fptr around htr post from previous row twice and skip st behind fptr, htr in next 5 sts – repeat from * across

[ROW 17]. **[wrong side]** Repeat row 3

[ROW 18]. **[right side]** ch2, turn work, htr in first 3 dc, * fptr around htr post from previous row twice and skip st behind fptr, htr in next 5 sts – repeat from * across

[ROW 19]. **[wrong side]** Repeat row 3

[ROW 20]. **[right side]** ch2, turn work, htr in first 2 dc, * fptr around htr post from previous row twice and skip st behind fptr, htr in next 5 sts – repeat from * across

[ROW 21]. Ch2, turn work, htr in first st, 1 htr in remaining along – DO NOT TIE OFF

[ROW 22]. **Border:** 3 dc into corner st, 1 dc along edge (evenly spaced along edges) – repeat around the square till 4 sides complete. Slst to join, tie off and weave in end.
