## Crochet Pattern (UK Terms)

If you are joining to the other squares, then make sure that the foundation row is 8 inches. If your row 0 is smaller than 8 inches in length, then add multiples of 7 chain until it makes 8 inches in width.

There is a right side (patterned side) and wrong side (working side) with this pattern so make sure you read the pattern carefully to prevent putting the pattern on the wrong side!

**[ROW 22].** Border: 3 dc into corner st, 1 dc along edge (evenly spaced along edges) – repeat around the square till 4 sides complete. Slst to join, tie off and weave in end.
