Tunisian Knit Stitch Square

Crochet Pattern (UK Terms)

You will need:

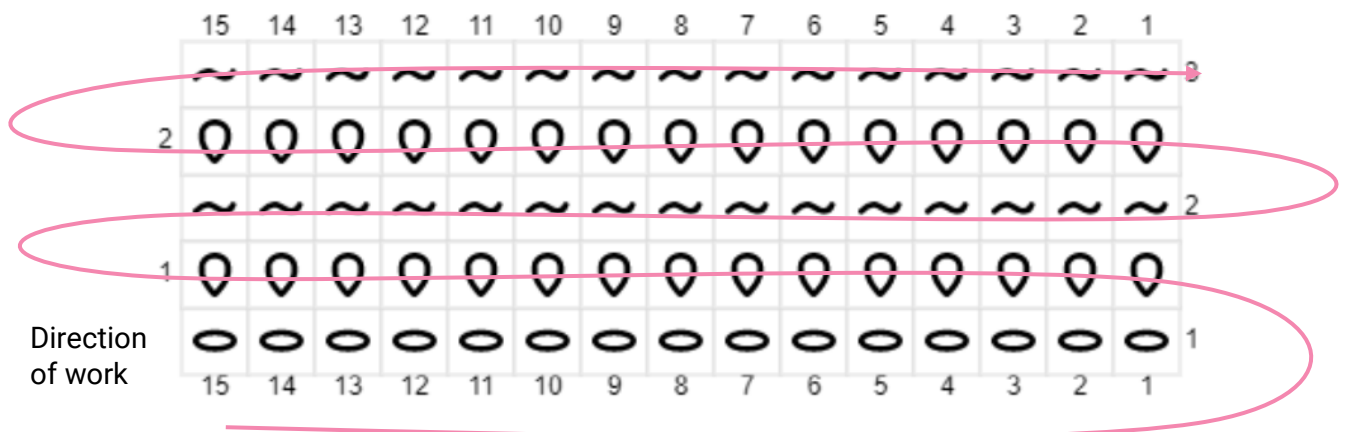
You will need:

- Tunisian Crochet Hook 6mm
- 25g DK wool colour of your choice

Useful abbreviations to read pattern

- **St** – stitch Sts – stitches **Slst** – Slipstitch **StM** – Stitch Marker
- **Ch** – chain
- **tk** – Tunisian Knit Stitch

Pattern (multiple of 1 + 1 turning ch)

Tunisian has a forward and reverse pass, so each row will have a F and an R annotation.

FC: With yarn chain (ch) 26 LOOSELY



R1F: Turn chain and insert hook into second ch from the hook, yarn over hook (yoh) and bring back through the ch so you have 2 ch on the hook. Repeat in all the ch on the fc so you have 25 ch on your hook. DO NOT TURN YOUR WORK – Tunisian Crochet is one side only!



R1R: yoh and bring through **one** loop, * yoh and bring through **two** loops, repeat from * back to the start of the row until you have one ch on the hook

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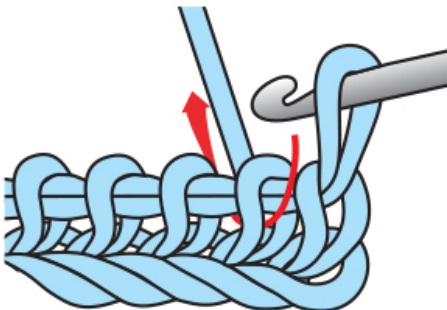
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Your foundation row is now complete we will now start the Knit Stitch

R2F: Insert the hook front to back in between the two vertical bars, yoh and bring back through the bar, repeat for each bar on your Foundation Row. At the end go through the edge stitching (2 threads), yoh and bring through.



R2R: yoh and bring through **one** loop, * yoh and bring through **two** loops, repeat from * back to the start of the row until you have one ch on the hook

Repeat R2F/R until desired height reached of 8 inches.

Slipstitch along length to close gaps and tie off.
