Little Crown (Sprig) Stitch

Crochet Pattern (UK Terms)

You will need:

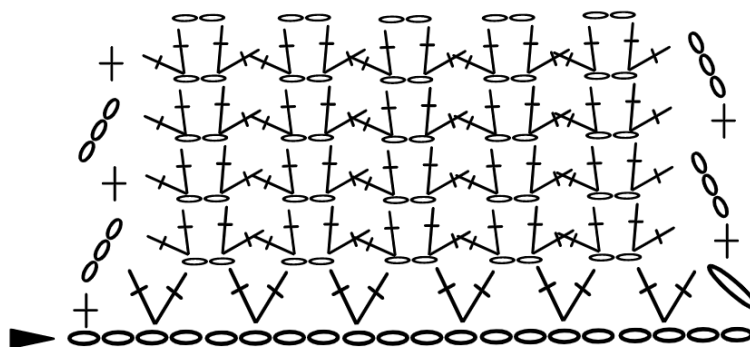
You will need:

- Crochet Hook 4-5mm depending on tension
- 25g DK wool colour of your choice

Useful abbreviations to read pattern

- **St** – stitch **Sts** – stitches
- **Slst** – Slipstitch **StM** – Stitch Marker
- **Ch** – chain
- **Dc** – double crochet

Sample and Stitch Diagram



Pattern (Multiple of 4 + 2 ch for turning)

If you are joining to the other squares, then make sure that the foundation row is 8 inches. If your row 0 is smaller than 8 inches in length, then add multiples of 4 chain until it makes 8 inches in width, then add 2 ch to turn.

This is a dual sided pattern so there is a no wrong or right side.

- ❑ **Row 0:** Chain 24 + 2ch – see note above for width
- ❑ **Row 1:** 2dc in 4th ch from hook, 2ch (becomes ch2-sp on next row), 2dc into next st, * skip 2 ch, 2 dc in next st, ch2, 2 dc in next st – repeat from * across to last 2 sts, skip 1 st and 1 dc in last st
- ❑ **Row 2:** Ch3, turn work, [2dc, ch2, 2dc] into each ch2-sp across, 1dc into top of turning ch from previous row
- ❑ **Row 3+:** Repeat row 2 until desired height reached – tie off and weave in ends or complete border below

Finishing

- ❑ Add a border of 1 double crochet (dc) evenly spaced around the edges with 3 dc in the corner stitches.
